We finish this term on Thursday after what has been a very good term indeed. The tamariki and kaiako have a lot to be proud of and my walkthroughs constantly capture our tamariki hard at work, learning and growing as people. It doesn't happen overnight but consistently, over time you can see them come out of their shell and become stronger and stronger.

Often this progress gets captured in things that represent the metaphor of progress that is school. The Māia plays at the Gryphon Theatre last

week, doing Midsummer Nights Dream and Macbeth, are remarkable pieces of work for a primary school, and show the capability of our tamariki and kaiako in action. Our Maia students looked strong, capable and confident. Tupu also shared their drama, and this is where the work all starts...consistently, over 7-8 years our students, by learning creatively, and striving for excellence, they are preparing to be lifelong learners. It is a team effort.
