



NUMBER RUMBA - A number facts fundraiser

This term KNS is running a **Number Rumba**, a number facts quiz similar to a spellathon. The **Number Rumba** will raise money to replace our aging Chromebooks and iPads, while also providing an opportunity for our tamariki to improve their basic mathematics skills.

The format is simple:

- In class, each child takes part in a mathematics assessment relevant to their age and ability
- With the help of their teacher, they set themselves a goal to improve on their result, and the child's goal will be sent home to whānau
- Using our online portal, Raise It, tamariki seek sponsorship for meeting their goal
- Tamariki will practice in class and at home, and are then assessed by their teacher at the end of Term 3

The overall result of the **Number Rumba** will be announced early next term. There will be spot-prizes and prizes for the class who raises the most money and also for the class who has the highest percentage of returns.

The goal of this fundraiser is to contribute funds to purchase new Chromebooks and iPads. If **every** child gets just three people to sponsor them, for \$15 each, we can raise over \$10,000!!
