This is our annual fundraiser where you can order calendars, sketch pads, greeting cards, mouse pads and diaries with your child's artwork.





Tupu Swimming Term 4

The Tupu team will start swimming next term at the Karori indoor pool. We will swim for eight weeks. The first session will be on Thursday, 9th October and the last session on Thursday, 27th November. There will be eight lessons in total.

Each team will be travelling by bus to the pool.

The Tupu Tahi Brown team will leave kura at 9.30am for their lesson from 10 to 10:30am and return at 10:30am.

The Tupu Toru Molloy team will leave kura at 9:50am for their lesson from 10.30 to 11am, and return at 11.30am

The Tupu Rua Corcoran team will leave kura at 10.15am for their lesson from 11 to 11.30am, and return at 12pm.

The Tupu Wha Di Somma team will leave kura at 10:35am for their lesson from 11.30am to 12pm, and return at 12.30pm.

The children will be grouped by ability and taught by qualified Swimwell swimming instructors in the indoor heated pool. Each swimming group will have an instructor in the pool with them for the 25-minute lesson.

Your child will need appropriate togs, goggles, and a towel, all clearly named and in a separate bag they can take on the bus. The children are expected to dress themselves independently. They will, therefore, need to wear clothes and shoes that they can independently put on and take off, please.

The donation request for these eight swimming lessons and bus travel is \$73. This will be added to your child's statement and can be paid by direct credit to 12-3223-0190001-00 using your child's name as a reference or by EFTPOS at the school office.
