Be honest and show consideration and respect for others at all times

- Always be considerate and thoughtful towards other people and their feelings.
- Uphold the school's zero tolerance for bullying.
- Show good manners at all times.
- Always speak politely and address all staff, visitors and adult helpers by their proper names.

Keep myself safe

- Hand my mobile phone into the office or class teacher.
- Wear clothing appropriate to my age.
- Wait quietly beside school crossings.
- Use school crossing when coming to and leaving school.
- Use computers according to the Kelburn Normal School Cyber Safety Agreement.

Look after my school and equipment

- Put rubbish in the bins.
- Care for gardens and plants.
- Respect desks/furniture.
- Take notice of the **Red flag** that closes the bottom part of the gully and the **Green flag** to wear a sunhat.
- Sign the school Cyber Safety Agreement and look after school computers, AV equipment and library facilities.
- Take home newsletters and all notices at the proper time.

Know how to behave in and around buildings

- Use a quiet voice inside.
- Walk down corridors.
- Stay out of classrooms and corridors on fine days.
- Refrain from leaning over stairwell banisters.
- Move quietly around the school during class times.
- Not throw objects around inside.
- Get permission/supervision when getting a ball out of bounds.
- Be BUSY doing QUIET activities on rainy days

Know the playground rules

- Obey the bells.
- Know where to play by the maps on classroom walls.
- Remain seated to eat my lunch until released by the teacher.
- Share sports gear and return gear at the end of lunchtime.

Know which areas are 'Out of bounds' for playing

- Climbing Trees.
- Digging and climbing on the banks.
- Balls off the roof and from the gully.
- Being behind the back of hall for playing.
- Being in front of the entrance to office.

I will avoid

- Interfering with others.
- Touching the belongings of others.
- Hurting others.
- Marking furniture, equipment and buildings.
- Bullying - continuing threatening behaviour
 - malicious name calling
 - physical intimidation.
- Misuse of email and text messaging.
- Returning inside at play and lunchtime on fine days.
- Getting into arguments.

I will not bring into school

- Weapons (like knives, swords, bows and arrows).
- Dangerous play equipment (like skateboards, roller skates, hard balls, golf balls).
- Gum.
- Glass bottles.
- Fireworks, matches and lighters.
- Game consoles.
- Drugs, cigarettes and alcohol.
